FIRST CIRCULAR AND CALL FOR PAPERS

We are pleased to invite you to the Study days on ancient glass entitled ARTE-FACTUM. Due to numerous excavations and several young scholars the research on ancient glass in the area of Slovenia and its neighboring countries has intensified in the past decades. Therefore, our meeting will focus on the ancient glass in the area of South-East Europe and the Balkans. Since there is no national AIHV committee in the region, we decided to invite you to Slovenia, which will give us an opportunity to share our experience, knowledge, research results and new finds.

The conference with a workshop will take place in Koper (Slovenia), the historical town on the Northern Adriatic Sea, from Friday, 6th March to Sunday 8th March 2020. It will be organized by the Institute for Archaeology and Heritage and the Department for Archaeology and Heritage at the Faculty of Humanities, University of Primorska, in collaboration with The Centre for Preventive Archaeology of the Institute for the Protection of Cultural Heritage of Slovenia.

Special attention will be given to the glass from prehistory till the Renaissance period in the region of South-East Europe and the Balkans. Therefore, relevant communications will be particularly welcomed. The Organizing Committee intends to combine a programme of lectures and poster sessions with a workshop and opportunities to visit relevant museums and collections.
